Overview

This conference is an interdisciplinary activity that brings together all Palliative Care stakeholders in Lebanon to raise awareness about the importance of Palliative Care for patients living with chronic illnesses as well as to identify gaps and challenges facing the Palliative Care discipline and put together a plan of action.

During our conference, we will shed the light about the importance of dying in dignity. We will focus on the role of spirituality in palliative care and the challenges faced by the Lebanese healthcare professionals in addressing this dimension.

The conference will be held in collaboration with the National Lebanese Palliative Care Society and the Lebanese Association of Palliative Care Nurses.

This activity is designed for healthcare professionals (physicians, nurses, social workers, psychologists, pharmacists, and other clinicians) who are interested in improving their clinical practice related to the provision of care for patients with serious illness.
