1. An abstract of 150-250 words describing your presentation should include:
 - Name of presenter, title, and credentials
 - Significance and importance of topic
 - Body of content, including the evidence/project/protocol/guideline to be presented
 - Conclusion

- Presentation methodology (Power-Point presentation or Poster presentation)

2. A Curriculum Vita of the presenter

Based on the themes of the conference and significance of the topic, the Scientific Committee will inform the candidates of their accepted abstract by **February 25, 2019.**
