Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of The Lebanese American University (LAU) Interprofessional Education (IPE) Program, it is our pleasure to invite you to the LAU IPE Conference under the theme of Interprofessional Collaboration in Acute and Chronic Care, which will take place on April 20-21, 2018. Day 1 will be at the Metropolitan Hotel in Beirut, and Day 2 on LAU's Byblos campus.

This is the second regional conference at LAU that addresses interprofessional education and practice. On Day 1, renowned academic and professional leaders from various disciplines will provide evidence- and practice-based information on the value and implementation of interprofessional learning, collaborative practice and the global-health perspective of IPE, followed by workshops on soft skills. On Day 2, a plenary session will address interprofessional work to improve quality and safety in acute and chronic-care settings, followed by a series of parallel interactive workshops of simulation activities. These will address bridging interprofessional education and practice, IPE assessment, and team-based approaches to managing various patient-care scenarios and clinical conditions such as sepsis, diabetes, obesity and post-bariatric surgery care.

The target audiences are practitioners/clinicians, academic and clinical administrators, quality managers, and faculty from health sciences and academic medical centers throughout the MENA region. To simulate real-world interprofessional teamwork, institutions will preferably be represented by groups of health practitioners from different fields (e.g., medicine, nursing, pharmacy, physical therapy, nutrition and dietetics, safety, quality, etc.) who routinely work together or plan to implement interprofessional learning and/or patient-care service models in acute and/or chronic care settings. The program will provide individuals and teams with knowledge and practical guidance on the benefits of IPE and its application with the aim of improving quality of care guided by a core set of values, consensus-building and shared vision.

## **Call for Abstracts**

#### Deadline for Abstract Submission: February 28, 2018 - ipe@lau.edu.lb

Abstracts should represent research and/or demonstrations to advance the fields of IPE and Collaborative Practice and be consistent with the overarching conference theme. We welcome submissions from all levels and types of practitioners, researchers and educators. Success stories, experiences and lessons learned from IPE or collaborative practice in the region are encouraged.

#### **Abstract format**

All abstracts must be submitted online. The abstract submission website will open on November 1, 2017. Submission are to be made in English. Please note that an incomplete submission cannot be saved online and therefore must be entered in its entirety. You will be asked to specify your preferred presentation type (oral vs. poster), however the reviewers will make the final decision regarding presentation format.

### The following information must be included with your submission:

- 1. Title
- 2. Presentation Type (Oral presentation or Poster)
- 3. Primary theme (education, practice, acute care, chronic care) You must select ONE or TWO primary themes.
- 4. Presenter Name(s) and affiliation(s)
- 5. Co Author Name(s) and affiliation(s)
- 6. Presentation Description (up to 500 words)

#### **Oral Presentations:**

Each oral presentation will be 20 minutes (15 minutes in length with a 5-minute Q&A at the end of the presentation).

#### **Poster Presentations:**

The maximum width of the panels is 120 cm. The recommended is an "A0" poster print size, which is around 115x84cm.
