The Nursing Symposium aims to enhance the knowledge of its nursing attendees with regards to issues facing young patients with breast cancer, including fertility, and pregnancy, as well as lymphedema and chemo-brain, both of which are more common than expected. Nurses will also explore the very common fear of cancer recurrence. Finally, nurses will advance their scientific knowledge with regards to HER2 low positive status and the recommended treatments. Their knowledge acquisition shall be self-reported by completing a survey using a 4-point Likert scale.
