Role Purpose

The MMU Nurse delivers high-quality, patient-centered care in mobile settings, ensures safe medication management, maintains accurate clinical records, and supports smooth day-to-day MMU operations in line with MoPH guidelines and organizational policies.

Key Responsibilities

Patient Care

- Identify care needs, triage, and implement nursing interventions with a patient-first approach.
- Prepare patients for examinations and perform routine diagnostics (vitals, point-ofcare tests) and procedures (injections, dressings, nebulization).
- o Educate patients and caregivers on treatments, adherence, prevention, and follow-up.

Clinical Monitoring & Documentation

- o Monitor and record vital signs, symptoms, and response to treatment.
- Document services in patient files and digital tools accurately and on time; support weekly/monthly reporting.

• Emergency Response

 Recognize and manage medical emergencies per BLS/ACLS protocols; stabilize and coordinate referrals/transport when needed.

Medication & Stock Management

- Prepare monthly medication refills for registered beneficiaries in coordination with the medical officer/pharmacist.
- Maintain MMU medicine, consumables, and equipment stock (FIFO, temperature control, expiries, counts); request replenishment proactively.

Quality, Compliance & IPC

- Follow national care standards, MoPH guidance, NGO SOPs, and safeguarding policies.
- Uphold infection prevention and control (IPC), waste segregation, and cold-chain requirements.
- o Participate in case discussions, audits, and continuous quality improvement.

• Operations & Teamwork

- Support daily MMU setup/breakdown, patient flow, and outreach activities.
- Coordinate with the physician, pharmacist, data officer, driver, and social workers;
 perform other tasks assigned by management to ensure smooth service delivery.

Qualifications

- Registered Nurse (RN) with a valid license from the Order of Nurses in Lebanon.
- Minimum 5 years of nursing experience; community health, primary care, or mobile/field work
 is a strong asset.
- Current BLS (ACLS preferred).
- Proven experience with medication administration and safe injection practices.
- Solid clinical documentation skills (paper and basic digital tools).

Core Competencies

- Patient-centered communication in Arabic and English (French is a plus).
- Strong triage, time management, and problem-solving under field conditions.
- Reliability, discretion, and respect for confidentiality and dignity of beneficiaries.
- Commitment to **Safeguarding**, **PSEA**, and non-discrimination principles.
- Ability to work some flexible hours based on outreach schedules.
