



The responsibilities and/ or tasks of the registered nurse required at the Jannah Dam & Lake project:

1. Assure compliance with regulatory requirements related to clinical operations.
2. Responsible for securing and developing all records, equipment, and programs related to occupational health services.
3. Collaborate with outside resources for program development, such as healthcare providers, third-party administrators, legal advisors, medical director, regulatory agencies, etc.
4. Evaluate and treat (as prescribed by doctor) all injuries and illnesses in an efficient and professional manner within the scope of practice and consistent with occupational nursing guidelines
5. Guide and direct all referrals to outside healthcare providers and services
6. Train and lead ergonomic team to assess jobs and provide input regarding ergonomic improvements
7. Administer AG's Drug-Free Workplace Program
8. Assist with the accident investigation program to identify root cause analysis of all incidents and near misses
9. Provide appropriate case management
10. Manage all cases to facilitate productivity, assuring appropriate care and return to work
11. Includes workers compensation, short- and long-term disability cases
12. Access healthcare needs, then implement and manage healthcare programs to improve health and facilitate return to work, maintain OSHA records/ reports and worker medical files
13. Assist departments with identifying, evaluating, and implementing accommodations and return to work options for workers with restricted duty.
