The RN provides a high standard of direct and indirect age specific patient care. The RN role includes nursing assessment, diagnosis, planning, intervention, evaluation, and coordination of care for patients and their families.

The Registered Nurse Implements the nursing process independently.

He/ She demonstrates an empathetic and caring approach to patients and their families and ensures that patients' dignity and respect is maintained at all times. The RN provides age-specific patient education.

The RN has the responsibility to protect patients, staff, and others against risks of acquiring healthcare associated infections. He/ She complies with the hospital policies and procedures related to infection control and prevention.

The Pediatric Nurse demonstrates competencies in and or knowledge of the complexities and the challenges involved in caring for patients in the pediatric floor.
