The RN provides a high standard of direct and indirect age specific patient care. The RN role includes nursing assessment, diagnosis, planning, intervention, evaluation, and coordination of care for patients and their families. The RN must be able to demonstrate the knowledge and skills necessary to provide care to patients admitted to Medical Surgical floors, which include medical, surgical, orthopedic and oncology cases. The RN is held responsible to meet clinical, educational, and quality patient outcomes, according to the hospital's policies, guidelines, and standards.

Tasks & Duties

- Provides a high standard of direct and indirect patient care.
- Monitors and evaluates the plan of care, implements nursing assessment and interventions that require substantial scientific and professional knowledge and skills.
- Communicates and collaborates with physicians and multidisciplinary team about changes in patient's condition.
- Performs complete physical assessment upon admission, every shift & whenever patient's condition changes and modifies health care plans as needed
- Plans patient care: assesses, implements and evaluates patient nursing care plan
- Coordinates care plan with physicians and healthcare team and contributes to the discharge planning and patient /family education
- Utilizes critical thinking skills in managing patient conditions and developing nursing care plans
- Demonstrates an empathetic and caring approach to patients and their families and ensures that patients' dignity and respect is maintained at all times.
- Responsible for providing and advocating for safe, compassionate, competent, ethical and evidence-based palliative and end-of-life care.
- Administers chemotherapy according to pre-set protocols.
- Monitors and evaluates treatment provided as per their scope.
- Participates actively in the implementation of change and improvement of practice in the clinical area.
- Participates in unit and hospital performance improvement (PI) projects for improving the unit standards.
